Its thereupon ordered by the Court that Commissioners Issue as by the Bel<sup>n</sup> aforesaid is pray and that John Scott, Wilm<sup>o</sup>. Hardy, Robert Mitchell and Peter Benton <sup>of Somerset County Gent.</sup> be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to act of assembly in such Case made and provided &c.

Joseph M<sup>r</sup>. Gester of Somerset County Gent. comes into Court and brings with him his Serv<sup>t</sup>. man called John White, who had run away and absented himself forty days out of his Service and likewise produced an account of four hundred and eighty pounds of tobacco for taking the said John White up and other Charge as appears by the same and. And prays the Court that the said John White may be adjudged to serve according to act of assembly in such Case made and provided

Whereupon the said John White present herein Court acknowledged the same Runaway time to be Justly due thereupon the said John White is adjudged by the Court to serve his said Master Joseph M<sup>r</sup>. Gester five days for every day he absented himself out of his Master's Service which amounts to two hundred days &c. and for the said four hundred and eighty pounds of tobacco paid for taking up and other Charge the said John White is adjudged to serve his said Master six months or <sup>Eight</sup> One hundred and eighty days which said Service is <sup>adjudged</sup> for the Runaway time and tobacco paid both amount in the whole to three hundred and eighty days. ~~The~~ said Service to commence at the expiration of the said John White's already servitude &c.
