being impannelled sworn and charged as aforesaid Return into Court, and severally called over
being asked if they had made any present to or found any Bill of Indictment. Return presented
against Joshua Edge Esq: Leger, Peter Filgennet and Bill of Indictment against Tom George
being content that the Court should amend form altering noe matter of substance in them, therby
on the grand Jurors were accordingly discharged and ordered that they be allowed of five hundred
of tobacco for their publick service this Court to be paid next Term Court and against the aforesaid
Joshua Edge and Blizd Leger so as aforesaid presented it is Ordered that Crier Issue Returnable
here to next August Court &c

any person, and to make their Report to Next Court &c
