Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit Francis Allen Gent: make return of a pannel of Grand Jurors, to Enquire for the body of Somerset County thereupon the said Sheriff Returns a pannel of grand Jurors as followeth to wit William Lane, John Townsend Junr, Moses Diiskill, Wm. Bowler Lewis Jones, John Waller, John Houghton, Thomas Humphrey, Thomas Walker, And^{rs} Coates, John Fleming, Thomas Coiter James Mumford John Burnall, Wm. Bratton, David Hazard, Daniel Gidery, John Denny, Ted John Trehearne, Thomas Bilemgi, Joseph Wailer, Elizth Duntou. Thereupon proclamation being made by the Crier in Common form & the Jurors afo^{re} as aforesaid being severally called over by their names do appear as above and thereupon they are sworn to Enquire for the body of the County afo^{re} and are charged and sent out to consider & soon after the grand Jurors afo^{re} being impanelled sworn and charged as afo^{re} return into Court, and severally called over & were asked if they had made any Presentm^{ts} or found any Bills of Indictm^{ts}. Return presentment against Joshua Dye Esq^r Logey, Peter Filgerne and some of Indictm^{ts} against Wm. George being content that the Court should amend form altering noe matter of Substance in them, thereupon the grand Jurors were accordingly discharged and ordered that they be allowed five hundred p^{ts} of tobacco for their Publick Service this Court to be paid next Seven Court and against the afo^{re} Joshua Dye and Elizth Logey so as afo^{re} presented it is ordered that Crier's Issue Returnable here to next August Court &c
