Whereupon the said Joseph Standford with George Dashiell of Somerset County Gentleman his Securitie present herein first acknowledged themselves to owe and be indebted unto the said Richardson Christopher his heirs or assigns in the sum of ten pounds Sterling money Duly and Severally to be made and Levied upon their body goods or Chattels Lands and tenements for the use of the said Richardson Christopher his heirs and assigns if default be made in the condition hereunder written

The Condition of the above Recognition is such that if the above bound Joseph Standford do during the Servitude of the aforesaid Richardson Christopher Learn him the trade of a Shoemaker and tanner and to Read the Bible and to give him at the Expiration of his Servitude a three year Old Pecker and a new Suite of Cloaths, and to feed and provide for him Said Servant Sufficient Meat drink washing Lodging and Clothing during his Servitude next for such an agreeable to have and wear £20 Then this Recognition to be void otherwise £20

Giddon Tilman [] Giddon Tilman son of Solomon Tilman aforesaid is bound by the Court and
bound to unto John Gale and John Tunstall and Edward North his Orson Servant until he arrives to the age of twenty one years being
Levi Gale and John Tunstall fifteen years of age the twenty third day of July Next the Said Giddon
and Edward North

Tilman to serve the said Levi Gale, John Tunstall and Edward North the first term or
time aforesaid, the aforesaid Levi Gale and John Tunstall and present herein Court promises for themselves
and the said Edward North that they will Learn him during his Servitude aforesaid as much of that Part of
Navigation as may be sufficient to Navigate a Ship or Vessel from one Port to another and
to keep him constantly to the sea, and to feed and provide for him Meat drink washing Lodging and
Clothing during his Servitude aforesaid next for such an agreeable to have and wear

Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court that the aforesaid Levi Gale and John Tunstall give Security for
to Saughly with the Covenants aforesaid

Whereupon the said Levi Gale and John Tunstall undertake
for themselves and the aforesaid Edward North and acknowledge themselves to owe and stand fully
indebted unto the said Giddon Tilman in the sum of twenty pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money
of England to be Levied upon their body goods or Chattels Lands and tenements for the use of the said
Giddon Tilman his heirs and assigns Duly and Severally if it happen default be made in the
Condition hereunder written -

The Condition of the above Recognition is such that if the
above bound Levi Gale and John Tunstall and Edward North do well and truly Learn the aforesaid Giddon Tie-
man during his Servitude aforesaid as much of Navigation as may be sufficient to Navigate a Ship or
Vessel from one Port to another and keep him constantly to the sea and do feed and provide for him during
his Servitude aforesaid meat drink washing Lodging and Clothing next for such an agreeable to have and wear
then the above Recognisance to be void £20
