 ing for the space of these Twenty years and upwards at a place called the mea-  
 ting house wappe up on Wiccomore Quay to which place the road proper as well as the said Land  
 belonging to Geo. Hutchins but now in J Head, and possession of Mr. J. Standiford to which place it has been  
 the custom not only off your petitioner but of all the upper part of d. Indebetance off Steagry Parish  
 to carry & deliver ~~the~~<sup>such</sup> goods to persons who have formerly done & still frequently do use to ~~do~~<sup>come</sup>  
 to those with Reholt to trade & also that d. Way to d. Landing has been a publick road for the  
 disinters to go to their Religious worships ever since their having had for their purpose meeting houses  
 built near d. Landing which has been by the space of time abt m<sup>o</sup>. they have never been interrupted  
 but since late possession of d. J. Head of d. Slipper Land etc who has now stopped up d.  
 said road to d. Landing (as well as to d. meeting houses) to d. disadvantage of your petitioner -  
 therefore pray to be relieved as it is in your worshipps power by your petitioner shewt gry 6.

The Petition and being Read and heard and Considered It is thereupon ordered by  
 the Court that the Pet<sup>n</sup> have Liberty to clear a road from the Ferry Road over Wiccomore  
 River near the Plantation of Mr. J. Head, to the Presbyterian Meeting House standing near  
 the said River, and that the said New Road to be cleared, and, be cleared according to the  
 direction of Thomas Hunninghrys and cedar Hitch, Hamst Moates and off least off -  
 Prejudice to any person &c

Ordered by the Court that George Dashott of Somersett County gent. Clear a road from the Ferry Road  
 (over Wiccomore River) to a landing on Wiccomore Creek, Opposite to Col. Gale's D. running.

Ordered that Col. Lewis Hale Clear a road from the Main Road, to Mr. Robinson Landing on Wic-  
 comore Creek &c
