Ordered by the Court that Thomas Ralph be Overseer of the Roads in Nauhooke hundred in the

from over Nauhooke River, and from the head of Tippin to Quanticoe Mill, and from the head
of Tippin halfe way to Stegney Parish Church, and from thence for her halfe way the road that
