One thousand seven hundred and twenty five being the day of the Return of the said Writ Comelli the said Joseph M^r Carter by his attorney afo^r and the Coroner of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise Comelli and Marshall return thereof to the Court here Under the Seal of Non, Est, Inventur, deicⁿ. Left at Last place of abode of Henry Ballard Coroner

Whereupon the said Joseph M^r Carter by his attorney afo^r pray, that for as much as he has Complied with the Law in Order to an attachment - he may have Judgment against the said Jonathan Raymond for his damages afo^r by way of attachment - according to act of Assembly &c. Whereupon for that it seemeth to the Court here that the said Joseph M^r Carter hath Complied with the Law as afo^redged,

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the fifteenth day of June and the said One thousand seven hundred and twenty five afo^r that the afo^redged Joseph M^r Carter recover against the afo^redged Jonathan Raymond as well the sum of two thousand nine hundred & sixteen pounds of tobacco his damages by Occasion of the premises afo^r as all costs and charges by the said Joseph M^r Carter paid out and Expended about his Suite by way of attachment against the goods, Chattels, Right, or Credits of the said Jonathan Raymond according to acts of Assembly in such case made and provided &c.

His William Copper's Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset that he should take Tobias Copper p. Tobias Copper ag^t - Late of Somerset County planter ad. deicⁿ. Tobias Copper Planter if he should be found in his Bailly writ and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordships Family Court of Somerset to be held at Diving Creek the thirteenth day of June then next to answer unto William Copper of a plea that he tender unto him five thousand pounds of good and Merchantable tobacco which to him he owes and unjustly detains &c. and that thereof he should not fail to - And the said William Copper by Francis Allen his attorney declared against the said Tobias Copper in the plea afo^r as followeth vid. Somerset County p. Tobias Copper Late of Somerset County Planter ad. deicⁿ, Tobias Copper Planter in the County of Somerset was summoned to answer unto William Copper of a plea that he tender unto him five thousand pounds of good and Merchantable Tobacco which to him he owes and unjustly detains &c. And whereupon the said William by Francis Allen his attorney saith that whereas the said Tobias the twenty fourth day of December and the said One thousand seven hundred & twenty one at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Bill Obligatory which the said William with the Seal of the said Tobias hereunto Court brings the date whereof is the same day and year did bind himself his heirs Executors and admors to pay unto the afo^redged William the sum of five thousand pounds of tobacco the one half to be paid in the year twenty two and the other half in the year twenty four in Country produce according to Markett Price at Snow Hill Nevertheless the said Tobias the afo^redged Required the said five thousand pounds of tobacco according to the tenor of the said Bill unto the said Tobias
