Whereupon the Said Joseph M'Garter by his attorney and pray that farre as he has brought
the Law in Order to an attaint he may have a Judgment against the said Jonathan Raymon for
his damages and by way of attaint according to act of Assembly &c Whereupon for that it Cometh to the
Court here that the Said Joseph M'Garter hath Complied with the Law as alledged,

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here the fifteenth day of June anno domini One thousand
Seven hundred and twenty five and that the said Joseph M'Garter recover against the aforesaid Jonathan Raymon
as well the sume of two thousand Nine hundred & Sixteen pounds of tobacco his damages by Occasion of
the premises aforesaid as all costs and charges by the said party paid out and expended about his Suite by
way of attaint against the goods Chittell Lights or Credits of the said Jonathan Raymon according to acts
of assembly in such case made and provided &c.

At William Cooper command was given to the Sheriff of Somersett that he should take Tobias Cooper
aforesaid Late of Somersett County planter ab dñe. Tobias Cooper Planter if he should be
found in his Baily wch and him should safe keep so that he might have his God
before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somersett to be held at Bridgwater the third
day of June then next to answer unto William Cooper of aplea that he lende unto him five thousand
pounds of good and Merchantable tobacco which he lende to him and longly delaines &c and that therof he
should not sue &c — And the said William Cooper by Francis Allen his attorney deputed against
the said Tobias Cooper in the plea aforesaid followeth videlicet Somersett County vs. Tobias Cooper late of
Somersett County Planter ab dñe. Tobias Cooper Planter in the County of Somersett was summoned to answer
unto William Cooper of aplea that he lende unto him five thousand pounds of good and Merchantable tobacco
which he lende to him and longly delaines &c And whereupon the said William by Francis Allen his attorney
Saith that whereas the said Tobias the twenty fourth day of December anno domini One thousand Seven hundred &
twentie One at Somersett County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certaine Bill obligatoy whereto the
said William with the Seal of the said Tobias heretointo Court bearing the date whereof is the same day and
year did bind himself his heirs Executors and adutors to pay unto the aforesaid William the sume of five thousand
pounds of tobacco the one halfe to be paid in the year twenty two and the other halfe in the year twenty
four in County produce according to Market Price at Snow hill Newcastell by the said Tobias the aforesaid
Required the said five thousand pounds of tobacco according to the tenor of the said Bill unto the
