We of the grand Jury do present Peter Filigence of Somerset parish for begetting
a bastard Child on the body of Isabell Miller on or about the 15th day of June last
1726.

There upon command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Peter
Filigence if he to answer w^r. And afterwards in the same Court came the said Peter Filigence and
being sent to the bar is Justly demanded how he would acquit himself of the gramin above
aforesaid. Says that he is guilty thereof and pray himself in Mercy of the Lord Proprietor.
and is willing to pay yearly Shillings fine for the fault aforesaid according to Law w^r —

Wherefore it is considered by the Court that the said Peter Filigence be fined to his Lordship for
the fault aforesaid thirty Shillings Court money of the use of Somerset County and that he be taken w^r. Whereupon
the said Peter Filigence is discharged paying the several Officers their fees due by means of the
Crown and the —

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the said Peter Filigence give Recognitione
with one Security in twenty pounds Sterling to have and keep him self the Inhabitants of Somerset County
from time to time and at all times hereafter from all just charges, trouble, and burthen whatsoever that
for or by Reason of the birth mentioned and bringing up of the said Child so as aforesaid begot off the said Isabell
Miller —

Whereupon the said Peter Filigence with Richard Knight his Security both present
herein Court acknowledged himself to owe and stand Justly indebted unto his Lordship the aforesaid
Lord Proprietor in the sum afforeinted pounds Sterling of their goods and chattels,
Land, and tenements severally to be levied and made up to the use of Somerset County if it hap-
pen default be made in the condition hereunder written —

The condition of the above Recognitione is such that if the aforesaid Peter Filigence
his heirs Executors or adutors do from time to time and at all times hereafter acquit discharge and save
himself the Inhabitants of Somerset County from all just charges, trouble, and burthen whatsoever for
or by Reason of the birth mentioned and bringing up of the said Child so as aforesaid begot off
the said Isabell Miller, and offend from all other just charges, trouble, and demands whatsoever
touching or concerning the same w^r Then the above Recognitione to be paid otherwise &c.
