Memorandum the Case by John Gale his attorney sued out his Lordship's Writ of attachment. the tenor whereof followeth in these words viz
Somerset to Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To y^e Sher^t of Somerset County

Greeting we Comend you if you attach any the goods Chattle rights or Credits of Tho^s Brown late of Somerset County Esq^r if they shall be found in your Bailwick to the value of Eleven hundred pound & when you have the same attached or any part thereof if same in your Custody safe keep you have the same before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Diving Creek in Somerset County a^d the third Tuesday of June Next then there to be condemned according to act of assembly for use of a certain John Boge unless the said Thomas Brown by himselfe or ally appear & answer unto the said John Boge in a plea of trespass upon the Case & according to Law by good & Lawfull men of your Bailwick you make known unto y^e person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment if she or they be appear before y^e Justices of our said County Court to be held as a^d to shew Cause if any she or they have why y^e same goods & Chattle rights or Credits as attached in her or there hands ought not to be condemned & Execution thereof had & made according to the forme of the act of assembly in such Case made & provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet & how you shall execute this Writ if you make known unto our said Justices at y^e same day & place a^d have you then & there this Writ Witness Samuel Hopkins Gent Chief Justice of our said Court the 25th day of Marching 12 year of our Dominion &c -
