Therefore it is Considered by the Court here the twenty sixth day of June anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty seven that the said Benjamin Wailes have his Execution against the said John Blizard Esq^r and of One thousand three hundred and Sixty One pounds off to him his debt and as also Two hundred and fifty Six pounds off to him by the Court unto the same Benj^t Adjudged for his damage which he had by reason of the detaining of the same Debt also Two hundred and fifty four pounds off to him by the Court here Adjudged unto the same Benj^t according to the form of the Statute whereoff lately made and provided for his Costs and Damage sustained by Quarrel off delay of execution of the judgement to be levied of the goods and chattels of the said Benjamin Copper, at the time of his death in the hand of the same John Blizard Esq^r and which in his hands he hath, and if so much in his hands he hath not than the Cost and Damage and Last mentioned to be levied of the proper goods and chattels of the same J^d Blizard
