The same day on the said Land came John Cropper an Evidence aged 26 years or thereabouts and being Examined as aforesaid that when Ebenezer Cropper settled his bounds of a separate fields that Capt William Pasitts was then there standing at the said settled bounds and said he wondered people did not take more care to settle their bounds for says he they that have no boundaries have no Land asking who owned that Land Over there pointing Over to one of the Courts of Land at the bottom of the aforesaid tract called Ratcliff adventure and the said Capt William Pasitts said if he could remember any thing about the bounds of the said tract called Ratcliff adventure it stood on the ^{point} and further saith not
