

County planter present herein Court in his own proper person undertakes for the said Michael Holland that in case the said Lewin Denwood shall Recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the said Michael Holland, or that the said Michael Holland shall be therein found that then he the said Michael Holland shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon unto the said Lewin Denwood or under his body to the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he if said Michael Holland shd. will doe it for him &c

Whereupon the said Michael Holland by George Darke his attorney comes and defends the force and injury whereof and says that he cannot gain say the plea his action aforesaid against him brought nor can he deny but that the Writing Obligatory aforesaid is his act and deed and that the debt therein mentioned is yett due and unsatisfied wherefore he prays Judgment for his debt aforesaid and his costs and damages sustained by reason of the detaining of the same debt

Therefore it is considered ^{by the Court here} the fifteenth day of June and doth One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five that the aforesaid Lewin Denwood Recover against the aforesaid Michael Holland as well the Sum of One hundred and sixty pounds Curr. money his debt aforesaid as also the Sum of four hundred and nine pounds of toll for his costs and damages by reason of the detaining the same debt to the said Lewin Denwood of his aforesaid by the Court here adjudged & the aforesaid doctm manage

And brings here into Court the Writing aforesaid which the debt aforesaid is from aforesaid doctm to wit whose date is the same day & year aforesaid &c Lewin Gale Quer. Elizes god doe k Roe
