Committed or which may hereafter happen to be done or attempted, and also of all those who in Our County aforesaid in riotous manner have gone or rode or shall hereafter presume to goe or ride with armed force against Our peace to the disturbance of Our people and of all such who in Our County aforesaid have done or shall hereafter presume, to dye in wait to maim or kill any of Our said People and also of all Ordinary Keepers and such other persons who have offended or attempted to offend or hereafter shall presume to offend or attempt to offend in the abuse of weights or measures or in selling of any Liquors according to the form of the acts of assembly for the Common good and profit now in this province made and used, and also of the Sheriff Bailiffs Constables and other Officers who have or shall hereafter misbehave them selves in the Execution of their Offices or have been far from diligent or negligent in the Execution thereof or shall hereafter happen so to be within Our County aforesaid and of all and Every the articles Matters and things whatsoever howsoever or by whomsoever in Our County aforesaid done or committed or that shall hereafter happen to be done or attempted concerning the premises or any of them, and to Inspect all Indictments so before you or any of you taken or to be taken or be for Our Late Justices of the peace within Our said County had and taken and not yett determined and process thereon against all or any person or persons so Indicted or which shall hereafter happen to be Indicted within Our County aforesaid to make and continue until they shall be taken Surrender themselves to be Cullowed and to here and determine all and Every the felonys, with crafts Enchantments Sorceries Arts Magicke trespasses forestallings Regrattings Riots Indictments and All other the matters aforesaid according to the Lawes of Great Brittain and this Our province had and used or to be had and used and the said delinquents and Every of them to chastise and punish by fines ransomes amerciaments forfeitures and otherwise according to the said Lawes and Customs of the said Kingdom and province and form of the Statutes and acts of assembly thereof had and used or to be had and used but we will not that you proceed in any the cases aforesaid to take life or member but that in Every such case, you send the prisoners with their Indictments and the whole matter depending before you to Our Justices of Our next Province: all Court to be hold for this Our province be it when soever or where soever to be holden there to be tryed - And we command you and Every of you diligently to Intend the Keeping the peace Ordinances and Statutes and all and Every the premises and that at your County Courts you make Inquisitions on and hear and determine as aforesaid doing therein what to Justice apperlines according to the Lawes and Customs of the said Kingdom and province aforesaid And further we do constitute Ordaine and appoint you the said Samuel Hopkins William Blanner John Jones, William Gasit John Smith - William Stoughton John Caldwell, John Manchester, John Handy, James Dushield, John Scot and Robert King or any three or more of you to Issue Out Writts Execiptions process and attachments and hold plea of Dyer and terminer of all actions popular and upon the Statute and of all actions (personall)
