Scott and Robert King and None Others to be Judges Also by these presents we do command the
Sheriff of Our said County of Somerset that at the severall Courts to be held for Our said County he give
his attendance and cause to come before you or any three or more of you as afo' such and so many
good and lawfull men of his Bailewick Out of each and every hundred thereof by whom the truth
of the matter in the premises may be the better known and Enquired of Lastly you shall cause
to be brought before you at your said Courts all Writs Precept Cross and Indictme to your Courts
and Jurisdiction belonging that the same may be Inspected and by due Course of Law determined
Witness Our trusty and well beloved Charles Calvert Esq: Our Lieut: General and Chief Governor
in and over Our said province of Maryland this Ninth day of July in the tenth year of Our Domi-
