His Lordship of Somerset County: Whereas this day to wit the fifth day of July 1725 a certain John Hoag
of Wickhamore was brought before us on Suspicion of felony and by the Evidence it doth
appear and that he is chargeable with the fact --- These are therefore in his Lordship's Name
to Command you to take the body of the said John Hoag into your Custody and him safe Keep so that
you have his body before the Justices of Somerset County Court to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tues-
day of August next to answer unto the above Complaint that he may be delivered by due Course of Law
here of fail you not at your peril and for your so doing this shall be your sufficient Authority and
Power given under our hands and Seals this day and year aforesaid ---

John Hoag

At which said third Tuesday of August and A.D. One thousand Seven hundred twenty five appears
here in Court the said John Hoag, in Custody of the Sher. of Somerset County into whose Custody was
committed for the Cause aforesaid - and thereupon the said John Hoag is again committed into the Custody
of the Sher. of Somerset County for the Cause aforesaid, until he deliver himself by due Course of Law &c
Whereupon the said Sher. Present herein Court took Charge of the said John Hoag accordingly &c

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court ^{that} Joseph Wailer, Henry Windsor, James Bonin, Sarah Dastick
all of Somerset County give Recognizance in forty pounds Ster. Each, for their appearance before the Justice
of apiec, Nisi quia, Oyer and Terminer, and Goal delivery, at Dividing Creek the first Tuesday of Sep-
tember Next to give Evidence on behalf of the Lord proprietary against John Hoag &c

Thereupon the said Joseph Wailer, Henry Windsor, James Bonin and Sarah Dastick
all present in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to Give and Stand Justly -
Indebted unto the Right honorable the Lord proprietary his heirs and Successors in forty pounds Ster.
Each, to be Levied on their Body, goods and Chattels, Lands or tenements for the Use of the said
Lord proprietary. In Case they do not make their personal appearance before the Justice of apiec
Nisi quia, Oyer and Terminer, and Goal Delivery, ~~to be had~~ at Dividing Creek the ^{first} Tuesday of
September Next to give Evidence on behalf of the Lord proprietary against John Hoag
and not to depart ~~the Court~~ ^{of the said Justice} without Leave &c

July in the tenth Year of the Dominion of his Lordship the Lord proprietary &c and
Dowd: 1725. Came before us the Subscriber two of his Lordship the Lord proprietary Justice,
of the Peace for Somerset County William Robertson, with his Securitys James Frain and Samuel
Mellson all of the County aforesaid and did acknowledge themselves to be indebted to his Lordship the Lord
proprietary and William Robertson in the Sum of twenty pounds Current Money and the said
James Frain and Samuel Mellson in the Sum of ten pounds --- Each apiec Like money aforesaid.
