Whereupon the aforesaid William Robertson in his own proper person appears and prays that his appearance may be recorded to save himself and security from the above Recognizance of Bail — Whereupon the said William Robertson's appearance is recorded, and he and his security accordingly discharged — Whereupon the said William Robertson is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to remain, until he shall be discharged by due course of Law — The said Sheriff being present took charge of the said William Robertson according to law —

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that Thomas Gordon give Recognizance in five pounds Sterling for his appearance before the Justices of the Peace Nisi prius Oyer and Terminer and Goal delivery the first Tuesday of September next and prosecute aforesaid William Robertson for Suspicion of felony &c — Whereupon the said Thomas Gordon present in Court acknowledged himself to owe and stand justly indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors in five pounds Sterling to be paid on his Body goods and Chattels Lands or tenements for the use of his said Lordship in case the said Thomas Gordon do not make his personal appearance before the Justices of the Peace Oyer and Terminer, and Goal delivery the first Tuesday of September next and prosecute the aforesaid William Robertson for Suspicion of felony &c —

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court Henry Windsor, William Phillips and Robert Ingram, give Recognizance in forty pounds Sterling for their appearance before the Justices of the Peace Nisi prius Oyer and Terminer and Goal delivery to give Evidence on behalf of the Lord Proprietary against aforesaid William Robertson — Whereupon the said Henry Windsor, William Phillips and Robert Ingram are present in Court acknowledged themselves to owe and stand justly indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors in the sum of forty pounds Sterling to be paid on their Body goods or Chattels Lands or tenements for the use of his said Lordship
