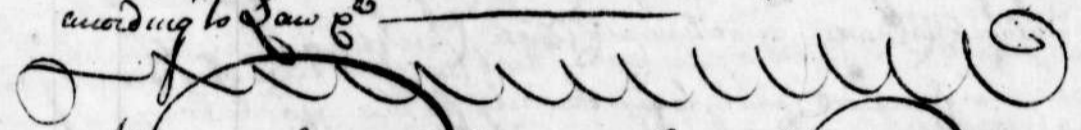


August Court --- 1725 --- 49
 August the Nineteenth day and Dowd: One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty four then came into
 Court certain Indians belonging to the Indian Town on Coromocke and did then and there make complaint
 before the Worshippfull Sam^r Hopkins Gent. and his associates Justices of the same Court Judicially
 sitting that severall of the Inhabitants living in and near the said Town that had horses and Mares did
 trespass upon them the said Indians, by breaking into their Corn fields and ~~cutting~~ ^{cutting} the same &c.

Thereupon Its Ordered by the Court that the same Indians make a pen or pond in
 the said Town. And putt in all such horses and mares as they shall find trespassing as aforesaid but if
 further it is ordered that the said Indians Injuring any such horses or mares as aforesaid on them
 trespassing that they the said Indians shall give the Owner of such horses or Mares due Notice
 according to Law &c.



William White son of Stevens White Late of Somerset County Gent. being
 of full age according to Law for the choosing his Guardian. Comes into Court and prays that he may
 be admitted to chose William Whittington of Somerset County Esq^r his Guardian. which is granted &c.

Thereupon the said William Whittington having all the Estate of the said William
 White in his hands both lease and personale Its Ordered by the Court that the said William
 Whittington give good Security unto the said William White ^{to} with the Law in Every respect
 Relating to Guardianship of ~~the~~ ^{the} said ~~White~~ ^{White}.

Whereupon the said William Whittington together
 with Joseph M^r Carter and Hugh Carter of Somerset County ^{Contractors his Security} present here in Court acknowledged
 themselves to Owe and Stand Justly Indebted unto the said William White his heirs
 and assigns in the full and Just Summe of twelve hundred pounds Ster^r; ^{money of Great Brittain} lawfully & Legally on
 their bodies goods or Chattels Lands or Tenements to be Levied for the Use of the said Will^m
 White. In case the said William Whittington do not in Every respect comply with
 the Law in Relation to Guardianship ^{and} Likewise do not deliver up ~~all~~ ^{all} ~~the~~ ^{the} ~~estate~~ ^{estate} to the
 said William White both lease & personale ^{made} when Legally demanded ^{made} quidly and
 peaceably ~~and~~ without any Molestation or disturbance whatsoever &c.
