affd John Donelson also --- Att which said Next Court to witt the seventeenth day of September and Dowd One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty four Cams againe as well the affd John Donelson as the affd Roger Nicholson Junr. by their attorneys affd and thereupon the said Roger Nicholson Junr. prayeth further Leave to Imparle hereunto untill the Next Court & he hath it and the Same day is given to the

affd John Donelson also --- Att which said Next Court to witt the eighteenth day of March and Dowd One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty four Cams againe as well the affd John Donelson as the affd Roger Nicholson Junr. by their attorneys affd and the said Roger Nicholson Junr. says he is not guilty and putteth himself upon the Country for tryall.

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Thereupon Command is given to the Sherif of Somerset County that Immediately he cause to come here twelve &c. by whom &c. who neither &c. to Pasquie &c. because as well &c. of which said Precept the said Sherif to witt Joseph M. Carter Junr. Now hereat this day to witt the Same day of Year last mentioned makes Return that he hath here twelve &c. by his precept he was Commanded. and now hereafterwards to witt the Same

day of year Cams as well the affd John Donelson, as the affd Roger Nicholson Junr. by their attorneys affd and the Jurors of that Jury therein Impanelled who being called Cams to witt, Adam Spence Junr, John Fleming, Peter Fryer, Charles Townsend, Samuel Alexander, Underwood Pancher, Richard Chambers, Robert Mitchel, James Rownd, William Braton, William Handy and John Caldwell Junr. who, being duly

Sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their Oath do say that the said Roger Nicholson Junr. is guilty of the premises, as the affd John Donelson above against him hath complained, and do affd the damages of the affd John by Ouerioi of the premises, besides his costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appoyred to thirty five Shillings, ^{and for those costs and Charges to One pound of tobacco} ---

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here the Eighteenth day of March and Dowd One thousand Seven hundred & twenty four that the affd John Donelson Recover against the affd Roger Nicholson Junr. as well the sum of thirty five Shillings ^{and for those costs and Charges to One pound of tobacco} and One pound of tobacco his damages affd by the Jurors affd in form affd as affd as also One thousand One hundred and Ninety Nine --- pounds of tobacco for his costs and Charges

by him about his Suit in that part appoyred the same John by the Court here at his Request of Increase adjdygd & the affd Roger in Money &c.
