as the afo Roger Nicholson Junr. by their attorneys afo and thereupon the Said Roger Nicholson Junr. prayed
further leave to Imparle hereto unto the next Court & he hath it & the same day is given to the
afo John Donelson also — At which said day & Court to wit the sixteenth day of March
anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty four came again as well the afo John Donelson
as the afo Roger Nicholson Junr. by their attorneys afo and the Said Roger Nicholson Junr. says he is not guilty and

Fleming, Peter Frazer, Charles Townsend, Samuel Alexander, Underwood Reulor, Richard Chambers,
Robert Mitchel, James Rardon, William Bratton, William Hardy and John Caldwell Junr. who being duly
Called tried & sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their Oath do say that the said Roger Nichol-
son Junr. is guilty of the premises as the afo John Donelson above against him hath complained, and doth pay
the damages of the afo John by reason of the premises, besides his costs and charges by him about his Suit in
that part appos'd to him, first summing up all those costs and charges to one pound of 1000 —

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the Sixteenth day of March anno Domini One thousand
Seven hundred & twenty four that the afo John Donelson Recover against the afo Roger Nicholson Junr. as well the sum
of thirty five Pounds first money and damages of tobacco his damages paid by the Jurors afo in form afo
as also One thousand One hundred and Ninety Nine — pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges
(154) by him about his Suit in that part appos'd to him John by the Court here at his Request of Increase adjudged
the afo Roger Nicholson Junr.
