The Court that the Child born of the afo<sup>d</sup> Anne Barker for which the said presented for a indenture  
and whereas there is due to Somerset County Seven Years service for such Indenture Cogulation  
according to an act of Assembly of this province, and likewise the said Child to become servant for  
One & Thirly Years to be disposed of for the use of the County afo<sup>d</sup>, Whereupon the said Child is  
sold by the court unto James Lindor of Somerset County until it arrives to Thirly One years of age  
In consideration whereof the said James Lindor is to pay unto, and for the use of the County afo<sup>d</sup> five hundred  
and ten pounds of tobacco at the next Sessions Court. Whereupon the said Ann Barker is ordered home to  
her master Service, and to serve him after the Expiration of her Servitude, being six feet six inches  
which was adjudged by the court as full Satisfaction for trouble lost & charge her master was  
at, at the time of her delivery of the Child afo<sup>d</sup>. Whereupon it is ordered by the court that the said James  
Lindor give recognizance in twenty pounds Sterl. for to return to the County Court or Sheriff of  
the County at the Expiration of her Servitude Whereupon the said James Lindor acknowledged  
him selfe to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of  
twenty pounds, Sterl. to be levied on his Body goods or chattels, Lands or tenements for the use  
of his said Lordship In case he doth not deliver her up to the County Court or Sheriff of the County  
at the Expiration of her Servitude afo<sup>d</sup> —

The same Somerset County Esq<sup>r</sup> We of the Orphan Jury upon our Oath do present that Will<sup>m</sup>  
William Whittington of Somerset County gent<sup>r</sup> Guardian to William White son of Stevens  
White late of the County afo<sup>d</sup> Gent<sup>r</sup>, doth not take care to Educate the said William.

Where according to the form of the act of Assembly in such case made &c. John Scarbrough foreman.  
Whereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should cause the afo<sup>d</sup> William  
Whittington to come before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court to be held at Dividing near the  
Third Tuesday day of August next to answer unto his Lordship Givering a証ment present in against him  
found and that whereof he should not fail to. At which said third Tuesday of August to wit the Seven  
twentieth day of the same month and day One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five being the day  
of the return of the said Will<sup>m</sup> Comell the Sheriff of Somerset County afo<sup>d</sup> Return thereon endorsed in
