John Scarbrough of Somerset County hath present in Court acknowledged himself to Owe and Stand Justly Indebted unto the Right honorable the Lord proprietary his heirs and Successors in the Sum of ten pounds Sterling to be Levied on his Body goods and Chattell, Lands or tenements for the Use of his said Lordship In Case the said William Hopkins is not of the good Behaviour during the pleasure of the Court, and not to depart without Licence there of

And afterwards in the Court Comar the same William Hopkins ^{same} and prays that his appearance may be recorded to save himself and Security from the above forequinsance of bail thereupon the said William Hopkins Appearance is Recorded and he accordingly Discharged &
