The condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound William Walton Henry Alexander and Nathaniel Wale their Executors and administrators do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above Said, John, Edward, Ebenezer, Elizabeth and Samuel Evans's Esqrs. as aforesaid their heirs Executors, admt. or assigns the sum and just sum of One hundred and forty One pound, ten Shillings, four money to be paid them according to Law and the will of the said Deceased when they shall attain to full years then the above Obligation to be void otherwise.

Wm Fairman — Dof. Doctor William Fairman of Somerset County Planter was summoned to answer  
unto Thomas Darkie of aplea that he Render unto him his due and just  
sum of One thousand and twenty four pounds of tobacco, which he had sent and from him  
he unjustly detaine d<sup>do</sup>. — And whereupon the same Thomas by Lewis Hale his attorney complaint that  
whereas the said William the tenth day of June and two score and thirteen hundred and fifteen at  
Somerset County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Writing Obligatory granted his aforesaid  
to be held and jointly Bound to the same Thomas in the sum of One thousand and twenty four pounds  
of tobacco to be paid the same Thomas when afterwards he should be thereto Required nevertheles<sup>s</sup> the  
said William held his. often thereto Required by the said sum of One thousand and twenty four pounds of  
tobacco or any part thereof to the said Thomas hath not Rendered but by the same billerets to Render  
that altogether delayed and still doth decay and unjustly detain<sup>d</sup> to the damage of the said Thomas two thou-  
sand pounds of tobacco and the said Thomas bringeth his billerets and the writing<sup>c</sup> by witness<sup>e</sup> —
