The condition of the above obligation is Such that if the above bound William Walton Henry Alexander and Nathaniel Wale their heirs Executors admors. or assigns do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above Said, John, Edward, Ebenezer, Elizabeth and Samuel Evans Orphans as afo their heirs Executors admors. or assigns the full and Just Sum of One hundred and forty One pounds ten Shillings Curr. money to be paid them according to Law and the will of the Said Deceased When they shall attain to full years then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force & virtue in Law
