James Kelly to answer unto William Whittington of a plea of the p^tg upon the case &c.

And whereupon the same William by George Hale his attorney Complains that Whereas,
the Said James the tenth day of May One thousand Seven hundred and twenty four at the County aforesaid
within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the same William Whittington in the sum of
Eighty two pounds ten Shillings curr^t. money of Maryland for divers goods ~~ware~~ and Merchandizes to
to him by the Said William before that time sold and delivered and so farre of being Indebted the Said
James in Consideration whereof afterwards to wit the same day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid willfully
aforesaid Jurisdiction upon himselfe assumed and to the said William then and there faithfully promised
that he when afterward he should be thereto Required he the aforesaid sum of Eighty two pounds ten
Shillings curr^t. money aforesaid to the same William would well and faithfully content and pay Nevertheless
the Said James did promise and affirme aforesaid in form aforesaid made not Regarding but Contenting and
fraudelently Indenting the same William in that part to defraud and deceive the Said James Kelly
the said sum of Eighty two pounds ten Shillings curr^t. money aforesaid or any part thereof to be
the same William alledg^t after by the same William thereto Required afterwards by ^t upon the tenth
day of August in the year aforesaid at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction aforesaid not paid or
the same William for it in any wise contented but the Said James, he the same alledged, to pay, or the
same William for it any way to Content him alledged refused, and still doth Refuse whereby
the same William says he is worse and hath damage to the value of One hundred pounds curr^t.
money and whereof he brings this suitte &c. - L G Hale Q C George Hale Esq^r for the defendant

Whereupon the Said James Kelly in his own proper person appears, and whereupon the Said James
Kelly at the prayer of the p^tg attorney aforesaid is adjudged to give a speciall Bail to the action aforesaid, but for want
whereof the Said James Kelly is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County where to remaine
the Said Sheriff being present took charge of the Said James Kelly accordingly. — Whereupon the
