 ditto Tobias Burck of Somerset County with the provision of Maryland planter was
 summoned to answer unto Lewis Jones Esquire of the last wife and testament of
 Samuel Jones Late of Somerset County dec'd of a plea that he Render unto him the sum of Just Sum
 of five hundred pounds of good sound merchantable Leafe tobacco and Casque which from him he unjustly
 detains &c — And where upon the same Lewis by John Gale his Attorney saith that whereas
 the said Tobias the first day of June Seventeen hundred and Eighteen at the County and within the Jur
 of the Court by his certain Bill with the same Lewis with the Seal of the same Tobias signed here
 into Court brings whose date is the same day and year and bound himself to pay unto said Samuel
 in his Lifetime the said sum of five hundred pounds of good sound merchantable Leaf tobacco
 and Cash upon the tenth day of November next ensuing the date of the said Bill never the less
 the said Tobias the said sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco or any part thereof to the same
 Samuel in his Lifetime or to the said Lewis since the death of the same Samuel hath not
 Rendered although often thereunto Requested but the same Tobias the said sum of five
 hundred pounds of tobacco and Cash hath not rendered hath altogether Denied & still
