Seven Shillings and Nine pence three farthings Curr^t money of Virginia for divers goods Wares and

and being so thereof indebted he the same Thomas in consideration thereof upon himself assumed

afterwards thereto Required unto the same Jeffry would well and truly Content and pay and altho the
ag^t Thomas by the hands of Afortani John Down hath paid Nine pounds and Seven pence

unto the same Jeffry yett the said Thomas his promise and assumption ag^t as to twenty one p^t
Seven Shillings and two pence three farthings Curr^t money ag^t the residue of the said thirty pound
Seven Shillings and Nine pence three farthings not Regarding but ~~holding~~ and fraudulently -
Intending him the said Jeffery in this part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the ag^t Twenty

same Jeffery hath not paid altho. So to do the ag^t Thomas the tenth day of february and Down

by the same Jeffery hath been Required but the same to him hitherto to pay hath Refused and still
doth Refuse to the damage of the same Jeffery forty pounds Curr^t money ag^t and thereof he brings
