County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted to the same Jeffry in the sum of Thirty pounds
Seven Shillings and Nine pence three farthings curr. money of Bergamia for divers goods Wares and
Merchantises by him the same Jeffry to the aforesaid Thomas before that time there sold and delivered
and being so thereof indebted he the same Thomas in consideration thereof acknowledged aforesaid
and to the same Jeffry then and there faithfully promised that he the same Thomas the aforesaid Thirty
Pounds Seven Shillings and Nine pence three farthings curr. money or aforesaid when he should be
afterwards thereto required unto the same Jeffry would well and truly content and pay and altho the
aforesaid Thomas by the hands of Clerken John Dower hath paid Nine pounds and Seven pence

unto the same Jeffry yet the said Thomas his promise and assumption aforesaid to werty One aforesaid

Intending him the said Jeffry in this part rashly and suddenly to deceive and defraud him thereby
One pound Seven Shillings and Two pence three farthings curr. money aforesaid or any part thereof to the
same Jeffry hath not paid altho so to do the aforesaid Thomas the tenth day of February anno Domini
One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three at the parish and County aforesaid within the aforesaid Jurisdiction
by the same Jeffry hath been Required but the same to him hitherto to pay hath Refused and still
doth Refuse to the damage of the same Jeffry forty pounds curr. money aforesaid and hereof the present
Suite &c. Tapewell Queen's Lawyer for the said K. H.
