hundred and twenty five came againe as well the afo^d Jeffry flower as the afo^d Thomas Billing by their attorney
afo^d and thereupon the said Thomas by his said attorney as before defend the force and Injury whereto
complaint is made.

And says that he did not affirme upon himselfe in Manner and form as the afo^d Jeffry above against
him selfe complained and of this he puts himselfe upon the Country &c. At the yest Day likewise —

Whereupon the afo^d Thomas Billini by his attorney afo^d Relinquisheth his Verification afo^d by him above
pleaded, and says that he is not informed by the same Thomas Billini his Agent of any answer for the same Tho.
to the afo^d Jeffry to be given and Nothing else thereof says by which the same Jeffry flower remains against
the afo^d Jeffry undefended — Wherefore the afo^d Jeffry flower his damages by Occasion of the Non performance
of the promise and Assumption afo^d Ought to Recover, but because it is not known to his Lordships Justice
what damages the afo^d Jeffry flower hath sustainted as well by Occasion of the Non performance of the promise
and Assumption afo^d as for his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part Expedited — Wherefore com-
mand is to the Sher. that by the Oath of honest & Lawfull men of his Baily wick or County he diligently
Inquire what damages the afo^d Jeffry flower as well by Occasion of the Non performance of the promise
and Assumption afo^d as for his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part Expedited and the Inquisition whereto he
should take to his Lordships Justice at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August next under his Seal, and
the Seal of those by whose Oath he make the same, he send with this writ thereto him directed &c. and the
same day is given to the afo^d Jeffry here also &c. —

All which said third Tuesday of

afo^d before his Lordships Justice at Dividing Creek Cometh the afo^d Jeffry flower by his attorney afo^d and the
Sher. returned after an Inquisition before him taken at the Wading place at the head of Bass Creek in

which it appears that the afo^d Jeffry flower sustainted damages by Occasion of the Non performance of
the promise and Assumption afo^d, besides his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part Expedited
Value of one pound seven Shillings and two pence three farthings curr. money of Vergesia, of the
Value of Twenty three pounds Nine Shillings and the Ten pence curr. money of Maryland and for those
costs and charges to Due pounds of tobacco —

Therefore it is considered by the Court here
