

August Court --- 1725 --- 62

Here in Court undertaken for the Said William Pepper that in case the Said Mary Martin Esq<sup>r</sup> or ag<sup>t</sup>. Shall Recover Judg<sup>t</sup>. in the pleas ag<sup>t</sup> against the Said William Pepper or that the Said William Pepper Should be thereunto Convict that then he the Said William Pepper Shall pay the Indemnity given of the Court heretofore or Render his body to the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the Said Somerset Sheriff will do it for him —

And the Said William Pepper in his own proper Person comes and defendeth the same and saith when as and says that he cannot deny the pleas her action ag<sup>t</sup> against him brought nor can he say but that the abovesigned Obligatory ag<sup>t</sup> is his act and deed & that the debt herein mentioned is yet due and unsatisfied wherefore the said pleas prayeth Judg<sup>t</sup>. for his debt ag<sup>t</sup> her costs and damages sustained by reason of the detaining of the same debt to her to be adjudged & —

Wherefore it is considered by the Court here the Seventeenth day of August anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred & twenty five that the ag<sup>t</sup> Mary Martin Esq<sup>r</sup> as ag<sup>t</sup> Recover against the ag<sup>t</sup> William Pepper as well the sum of fifteen hundred and Nineteen pounds of tobacco her debt ag<sup>t</sup> as also the sum of Two hundred and Seventy six — pounds of tobacco for her costs and damages sustained by reason of the detaining of the same debt to the same Mary Martin of her agent by the Court here adjudged & the ag<sup>t</sup> doth in Mercy & —

Lg. The Same

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he Should take Michael Holland — Michael Holland of Somerset County Mariner at Durh. Michael Holland of Annanfer in the County of Somerset Mariner if he Should be found in his Baylwick and him Should Safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of August next to answer unto Mary Martin of Brentroe of the last will and testament of Robert Martin decd. of a plea that he render unto her thirly two pounds, purt. Silver Money which from her he unjustly detains &c and that thereof he Should not fail &c —

And whereupon the same Mary by her attorney complains that whereas the ag<sup>t</sup> Michael Holland the third day of August anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty three at Somerset County ag<sup>t</sup> within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Writing Obligatory granted himself to be held and firmly bound unto the ag<sup>t</sup> Robert Martin in his Life twice in the sum of thirly two pounds, purt. Silver money of this province to be paid unto the Said Robert Martin his heirs Executors adutors or assigns when afterward he the Said Michael Should be thereunto Required nevertheless the said Michael altho often thereto Required has the sum of thirly two pounds of purt. money and
