Whereupon the Said Charles Ramsey in his own proper person appears and therupon the Said Charles Ramsey at the prayer of the other attorney is adjudged to give Special Bailie to the action ofd Whereupon John Barnett Ramsey and William Merrett both of Somerset County Plaints present here in Court tendertakes for the Said Charles Ramsey that if in case the Said John Sawes shall Recover Judgment in the place of against the Said Charles Ramsey or that the Said Charles Ramsey shall be therin found that then he the Said Charles Ramsey shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or Render his body to the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that they the said Barnett Ramsey and William Merrett will do it for him.

And the said Charles Ramsey in his own proper person comes and defend the same and doth say and say that he cannot gainsay the p^t h^t his actions of against him brought nor can he say but that the Writing Obligatory of is his act and deed and that the debt therein mentioned is yet due and unsatisfied wherefore the Said p^t h^t pray Judgment for his debt and his costs and damages sustained by occasion of the detaining of that same debt to him to be adjudged &c.

Wherefore it is considered by the Justices here the seventeenth day of August anno domini One thousand seven hundred and twenty five that the aforesaid John Sawes Recover against the aforesaid Charles Ramsey as well the sum of Sixty pounds curr^t money of Maryland his debt aforesaid as also the sum of Three hundred & Seventy Seven - - - pounds of tobacco for his costs and damages sustained by occasion of the detaining that same debt to the same John Sawes of his agent by the Court here adjudged & the aforesaid debt in money to be paid to him.
