to Thomas Ralph -- } to Thomas Ralph until he arrives to the age of twenty One years he being
two years of age the Seventh day of July next the Said Isaac Fowler to Learn by the Said
Thomas Ralph during his Servitude aforesaid the trade of attorney and to Read well in the Bible, and
at the Expiracion of his Servitude to Give him a three year Old heifer and a Suit of
Cloathes &c. Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court that the Said Thomas Ralph give Security
to Comply with the Covenants aforesaid —

Thereupon the Said Thomas Ralph with Nicholas Evans his Security both pre-
sent in Court acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the Said Isaac Fowler in the sum of
fifty pounds Sterling to be Sevied upon their body or goods or Chattell Lands or tenements
Joyfully and Severally for the use of the Said Isaac Fowler In case the Said Thomas
Ralph do not Learn him the trade of attorney and to Read well in the Bible and give him
a three year Old heifer and a suit of Cloathes at the Expiracion of his Servitude aforesaid —

to John Collins — } Collins until She arrives to the age of Sixteen Years, She being from year
of age . the Said Sarah Fowler to Serve the Said John Collins until she arrives to the age
aforesaid the said John Collins to Learn the said Sarah Fowler to Read Knitt Sew and Spin & other
housewifery during her Servitude and at the end thereof to give her a young heifer of three years
Old and a Suit of apparel &c —

Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court that the Said John Collins give Security for the
performance of the Covenants aforesaid — Thereupon the Said John Collins with Thomas Ralph
his Security both present in Court acknowledged themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted
unto the Said Sarah Fowler in the sum of fifty pounds Sterl. to be Sevied upon their Body Goods or
Chattell Lands or tenements Joyfully and Severally to be Sevied for the use of the Said Sarah Fow-
ler In case the Said John Collins do not Comply with the Covenants aforesaid —
