Jointly and Severally for the Use of the Said Isaac Fowler In Case the Said Thomas  
Ralph do not Learn him the trade of a tanner and to Read well in the bible and give him  
a three year Old heifer and a Suite of Cloaths at the Expiration of his Servitude of 8<sup>o</sup> —

housewifery during her Servitude and at the End thereof to give her a young heifer of three years  
Old and a Suit of Apparell &c —

Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court that the Said John Collins give Security for the  
performance of the Covenants aforesaid. Thereupon the Said John Collins with Thomas Ralph  
his Security both present in Court acknowledged themselves to Owe and Stand Justly Indebted  
unto the Said Sarah Fowler in the Sum of fifty pounds Sterd. to be Seized upon their body, Goods or  
Chattels Lands or tenements Jointly and Severally to be Seized for the Use of the Said Sarah Fow-  
ler In Case the Said John Collins do not Comply with the Covenants aforesaid —
