of ^{his Lordships} County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March next
to answer unto his Said Lordship Concerning all Such Matters and things as Shall be Objected ag-
ainst him on his Said Lordships behalf and not to depart the Same Court without Licence thereof
