thereupon the said Robert Martin by his said attorney Prayed further Leav to Imparte  
heremto until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the afofr Francis Merer  
also — all which said next Court to with the sixteenth day of March hundred One thousand  
Seven hundred and Twenty four Comt again as well the afofr Francis Merer as the afofr  
Robert Martin by their attorneys afofr — And the same attorney saith that he is not informed by the same  
Robert Martin his Cownt of any Answer for the same Robert to the afofr Francis Merer in the year afofr to  
begin, and nothing else more of late, by that the same Francis Merer Remains against the afofr Robert  
Martin thereof undefended &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the same day and year  
last mentioned that the afofr Francis Merer Recover against the afofr Robert Martin as well the sum of  
One hundred <sup>Pounds</sup> curr. money of Maryland his debt afofr as also the sum of three hundred and sixty five  
pounds of tobacco ~~expences~~ for his Damages whilke he sustained as well by Occasion of the Detention of that same  
Debt as for his costs and charges by him about his Suite in that court Regarded, the same Francis Merer by the Court  
here of his afofr adjudged of the afofr Robert in Mercy &c.
