Allen &

Christopher Glasp } Be it Remembered that this day to wit the Eighteenth Day of November Seventeen hundred and twenty five came into the Court of the Right honorable the Lord Proprietary of this Province for the County of Somerset Levi Gale Esq. of the Indictments of the said County and for the Lord Proprietary gives the Court here to understand and be Informed that Christopher Glasp Late of the County of Glanster the tenth day of October Seventeen hundred and twenty five to Askimincouson Indian Town in the County of within the Jurisdiction of this Court did carry three Gallons of Syder and in the said Indian Town in the County of within the Jurisdiction of the said Christopher did then to sundry Indians vend and dispose of the said three Gallons of Syder against the peace & also agt the form of the act of Assembly in such case made and provided whereof the said Levi Gale for the said Lord Proprietary prays advisment of the Court herein the premises and that due process of Law may Issue

Whereupon Command is given to the Sher. of Somerset County that Immediately he take of the said Christopher Glasp Late of the County of Glanster. if he to answer &c. And afterwards in the same Court comes the said Christopher Glasp in Custody of the said Sher. and thereupon the said Christopher Glasp being set to the Bar, and Information Read pleads Guilty and puts himself upon the favor of the Court ^{with a protestation of his Innocency.} because he will not plead with the said Lord Proprietary and is willing to make fine to the said Lord Proprietary for the fact aforesaid

Wherefore it is Considered by the Justice here that Christopher Glasp be fined to his Lordship for the fact aforesaid One thousand pounds of tobacco the one half thereof toward the Support,
