Such matters and things as shall be then and there Objected againſt him on his Said Lordship's
be halfe and to pay and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon, and not to depart the ſame
Court without ſigning thereof and in the mean time that he be of the good behaviour toward
his Said Lordship and all his Liege people and more Especially to the aſt Men. Attest

His Lordship Somersett County Esq: Be it Remembred that this day to wit the Eighteenth
Christopher Glaf. day of November Seventeen hundred and twenty five came into the Court of the
Right honourable the Lord proprieſary of this province for the County of Somersett
Leoni Hale Cld. of the Indictments of the Said County and for the Lord proprieſary gives the Court
here to understand and be informed that Christopher Glaf late of the County aſt Blanter.
The tenth day of October Seventeen hundred and twenty five to Askininiconson Indian Town
in the County aſt within the Jurisdiction of this Court did carry three Gallons of Syder and in the ſaid
Indian Town in the County aſt within the Jurisdiction aſt the ſaid Christopher did then to many
Indians vend and diſpoſe of the ſaid three Gallons of Syder againſt the peace & good and also ag^t
the form of the act of Assembly in ſuch case made and provided whereof the ſaid Leoni Hale
for the Said Lord proprieſary prays aduertment of the Court heresv^t the premises and that due
proceſs of Law may be done — I Gile f. Dow Croſſ —

Whereupon Command is given to the Sheriff of Somersett County that Immediately
he take of ſaid Christopher Glaf late of the County aſt Blanter if he do ouer &c And after-
ward in the ſame Court comes the ſaid Christopher Glaf in custody of the ſaid Sheriff and
Thereupon the ſaid Christopher Glaf being Set to the Bar and Information Read pleads
Guilty and putt himself upon the will to proteſtation of his Juſticiary.
And is willing to make ſuice to the ſaid Lord proprieſary for the fact aſt —
