bros Roggius Indt. in the Name of God and the said Lord proprietary then and there being an assault
did make and him did beat wound and evilly treat so that of his Life it was endangered and other harms
then & there he did do to the great damage of the said Ambros and against the Peace & whereof the
said Lewis for the said Lord proprietary prays advisement of the premises and that due course of

Thereupon Command is given to the Sherd. of Somerset County that he should take the said John
Fleming and Grace his wife if &c to answer &c. and afterwards in the same Court Cometh the said John Fleming
and Grace his wife in custody of the Sherd. and being by the said Sherd. sett to the bar & Information Read
pleads guilty and putt themselves upon the favour of the Court with a protestation of their Innocency be-
