The Same Somerset County & Be it Remembered that this day to wit the Sixteenth day of Novemb:  
Seventeen hundred and twenty five came into Court [of the Right hould the Lord Proprietary  
J.W. Fleming Eliz<sup>r</sup> of Maryland] for Somerset County Lewin Gale Esq<sup>r</sup> of the Inhabit<sup>t</sup> of Said County and for  
the Said Lord Proprietary gave the Court to understand and be informed that John & Cannon  
late of Somerset County Elznter and Grace his wife the tenth day of August Seventeen hundred and twenty  
five with force and Arme's at the County afo<sup>d</sup> within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Am-  
brop Rigg in Jnd<sup>d</sup>. in the Peace of God and the Said Lord Proprietary then and there being an assault  
Did make and hau<sup>d</sup> did beat wound and bodily treat so that of his Life it was despaired and other伤害  
then & there he did do to the great damage of the Said Ambrop and against the Peace & where of the  
Same Lewin for the Said Lord Proprietary pray<sup>d</sup> Advicement of the premises and that due process  
of Law may Issue & Lewin Gale Esq<sup>r</sup> Dated 20 Dec<sup>r</sup> 1725.

Whereupon Command is given to the Sher<sup>d</sup>. of Somerset County that he Should take the Said Jn<sup>d</sup>.  
Fleming and Grace his wife if & to answer & and afterwards in the same Court before the Said Jn<sup>d</sup>.  
Fleming and Grace his wife in custody of the Sher<sup>d</sup>. and being by the Said Sher<sup>d</sup>. Sett to the Bar & Information Read  
pleads Guilty and putt themselves upon the favour of the Court with a protestation of their Innocency be-  
cause they will not plead with the Lord Proprietary, and are willing to make fine to the Said Lord Pro-  
prietary for the fact afo<sup>d</sup> - - Wherefore it is Considered by the Justice that the afo<sup>d</sup> Jn<sup>d</sup>.  
Fleming and Grace his wife be fined to his Lordship for the fact afo<sup>d</sup> the sum of fifty pound of tobo.  
Each &c. Whereupon the Said Jn<sup>d</sup>. Fleming and Grace his wife are committed into the Custody of the Sher<sup>d</sup>. of  
Somerset County there to remaine & the Said Sher<sup>d</sup>. present took Charge of the Said Jn<sup>d</sup>. Fleming and  
Grace his wife accordingly &
