Somerset s<sup>r</sup>: Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the

Crownes of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we Command you that you attach any the good Chattels Rights or Credits of Michael Holland of Somerset County Maryland or duties Michael Holland of any name or sort in the County aforesaid if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of Sixteen pounds Current money and three hundred and thirty One pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before the Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County aforesaid the third Tuesday of November Next then there to be condemned according to act of assembly to & for the use of a certain Mary Martin Esq<sup>r</sup> of Last will & testament of Robert Martin deceased unless y<sup>e</sup> said Michael Holland by himselfe or his attorney shall appear answer unto y<sup>e</sup> said Mary Martin in a plea that he tender unto her thirty two pounds Current money which from her he unjustly Detaines &c according to Law & that by good & Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto y<sup>e</sup> person or persons in whose hands you make y<sup>e</sup> same attachment that he she or they be & appear before y<sup>e</sup> Justices of our said County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew Cause if any he she or they have why y<sup>e</sup> same goods or Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands Ought not to be condemned & Execution thereof had & made according to y<sup>e</sup> form of y<sup>e</sup> act of assembly in such Case made & Provided if to him her or them it shall seem mete & How you shall Execute this Writt that you make known unto our said Justices at y<sup>e</sup> same day & Place aforesaid & have you then & there this Writt Witness Samuel Hopkins Gent<sup>l</sup> Chief Justice of our said Court the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August in the 10<sup>th</sup> year of our Dominion &c Anno Dom<sup>i</sup> 1725 —

At which said third Tuesday of November to wit the sixteenth day of the same month and Dominion One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five being the day of the Return of the said writt Cometh the said Mary Martin by her attorney aforesaid and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed Likewise Cometh and maketh Return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words following viz Attached full value and have the money ready here in Court. Fra Allen Sher<sup>iff</sup>.
