to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of afo^r Mary Martin Esq^r of
the last will and testament of Robert Martin deceased Unto the said Jonathan Raymond by himself
or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Mary Martin Esq^r afo^r in a plea of trespass
upon the case according to law and that by good and lawful men of your Bailiwick you make known
unto the Person or persons in whose hands you have the same attachment, that he she or they be
and appear before the Justice of Our County Court to be held afo^r to shew cause if any he she or they
have why the same goods or chattels Rights or credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to
be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of assembly in such
case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seeme right and law you shall execute this Writ
that you make returne unto Our said Justice at the same day and place afo^r and have you then
