the last will and testament of Robert Martin dec^d Unless the said Donathan Raymond by himself
or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Mary Martin Executrix or aforesaid in a plea of tergivers
upon the case according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known
unto the Person or persons in whose hands you make the Same attachment, that he she or they be
and appear before the Justice of our ^{said} County Court to be hold aforesaid to shew cause if any he she or they
have why the Same goods or Chattels Rights or credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to
be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of assembly in such
Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this Writ
