

Make known unto y^e a^d George Hutchins that he be & appear before of our Justices of our County Court to be held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County a^d the third Tuesday of Novemb: Next to shew Cause if any thing for himselfe he hath or knoweth to say why the a^d Mary Martin & c^o as a^d should not have her Execution against him for y^e Damages & Costs a^d according to y^e form of the Recovery a^d she Ought not to have if to him it shall seem Expedient & have you then & there the Names of those by whom you make y^e same known & this writt Wittness Samuel Hopkins Gent Chief Justice of our Said Court y^e Nineteenth day of August in y^e tenth Year of our Dominion & Anno D^{omi}ni: 1725 -

At which said third Tuesday of Novemb: to witt the Sixteenth day of ^{the same Month} and Dow One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty five being the day of the Return of the said writt Cometh the said Mary Martin & c^o a^d by her attorney a^d the Sher: of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed & sheweth Cause & maketh Return thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these words: *and made known & read Aloud*

Whereupon the a^d Mary Martin by her said attorney prayeth that the said George Hutchins to her writt of Sureties a^d may answer but the said George Hutchins altho' solemnly called Cometh not nor sheweth Cause why & c^o but maketh default whereby the said a^d Remains against the a^d debt thereof wholly Undeferred & - Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the same day and Year Last mention- ed that the a^d Mary Martin & c^o of the same Robert Martin have Execution against the said George Hutchins of the Judgmt: a^d as well for the Sum of One thousand Six hundred and fifty Six pounds of Tobacco Damages as also the Sum of two hundred and forty two pounds of Tobacco Costs of Suite in the Judgmt: a^d as also for the Sum of Two hundred and fifty Eight - - - - - pounds of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto him for his Costs and Damages Sustained by Quasion of Delay of Execution of y^e Judgmt: a^d & c^o

a^d Robert Givan - - - - - } Robert Givan late of Somerset County Planter if he should be found in his bai-
lywick and him should safe Keep so that he should have his Body before
the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek the
third Tuesday of Novemb: then next to answer unto William Emalls of a plea of trespass upon the Case &
and that thereof he should not fail & c^o

And the said William Emalls by Dewi Gale his attorney declared against the said Robert Givan in the
plea a^d as followeth viz^t - Somerset County s^h Robert Givan late of Somerset County planter was attach-
ed to answer unto William Emalls of a plea of trespass upon the Case & c^o -

And whereupon the said William by Dewi Gale his attorney Complains that whereas the said
Robert the twenty sixth day of March and Dow One thousand Seven hundred and twenty four at the
County a^d within the Jurisdiction of this Court was Indebted unto the said William in the Sum of thirteen
hundred and sixty nine pounds of Tobacco as by an a^d thereof thereunto annexed may be Court appear
and being so thereof Indebted the said Robert in Consideration thereof afterwards to witt the day
and Year a^d at the place a^d in Consideration thereof upon himselfe did assume and to the same Will-
iam Emalls
