Colbourn should be there to required Nevertheless the said Colbourn did. After there to Required the said Sum of two thousand three hundred and seventy eight pounds of tobacco to the same Joseph but not Rendered but he the same hitherto, to the same Joseph to render hath altogether denyed and still doth deny whereby the same Joseph says he is the worse and hath damage to the value of three thousand pounds of tobacco and thereof brings this

And whereupon the said Colbourn Taylor being called appears and thereupon the said Colbourn Taylor at the prayer of the Cfts attorney is adjudged to give Speciall Bail to the action afo, but for want thereof the said Colbourn Taylor is committed into the custody of the Sherif of Somerset County there to continue &c. — And afterwards in the same Court Cometh a certain John White of Marnisco in Somerset County Esquire and undertakes for the said Colbourn Taylor that if in case the said Joseph Master shall Recover Judgment in the plea afo against the said Colbourn Taylor or that the said Colbourn Taylor shall be therein found that then he the said Colbourn Taylor shall pay the Expenditures of the Court thereupon or render his body to the Custody of the Sherif of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said John White will do it for him &c. —

whereupon the said Colbourn Taylor in his proper person Cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when &c and says that he cannot gainsay the plea his action afo against him brought nor can he say but that the writing Obligatory afo is his act and deed & that the debt therein mentioned is yett due and unsatisfied wherefore the said plea pray Judgment for his debt afo & his costs and Damages sustained by occasion of the detaining of the same Debt to him to be adjudged &c. —

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the Sixteenth day of November and Done One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five that the said Joseph Master Recover against the said Colbourn Taylor as well the Sum of two thousand three hundred seventy and eight pounds of Tobacco his debt afo as also the Sum of three hundred and eighty nine --- pounds of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged unto him for his costs and Damages sustained by occasion of the detaining of the same debt &c of afo depth in merry &c memorand. of afo Release the penalty Reserving of principle debt and Interest untill payment &c. —
