the same Walter should be thereunto Required Never the less the said Walter altho' often thereto require
d the said Sum of two thousand three hundred and Seventy Eight pound of tobacco to the same Joseph
hath not Rendered but the same hitherto to the same Joseph to tender hath altogether denyed and Still
doth deny where by the same Joseph says he is worn and hath damage to the value of three thousand
pound of tobacco and therefore brings this Suite & the same Joseph brings hereto fornt the
writing Obligatory of & I Gale & Reed Esqrs & In Doc K K

Whereupon the said Walter T aylor being called appears and thereupon the said Walter Tay
ler at the prayer of the p^r attorney is adjudged to give Special Bail to the action and but for
want thereof the said Walter T aylor is committed into the Custody of the Sherif of Somerset County
there to remaine & And afterwards in the same Court Cometh ~~the~~ John White of Marston
Esq in Somerset County Clanker in his proper person and undertakes for the said Walter T aylor
that if in case the said Joseph M^r Maister shall recover Judgment in the plea and against the said Walter
T aylor or that the said Walter T aylor shall be therein convicted that then he the said Walter T aylor
shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his Body to the Custody of the Sherif
of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said John White will do it for him &

Whereupon the said Walter T aylor in his proper person Cometh and defendeth the force
and Injury when he and sayth that he cannot gain say the p^r his action and against him brought
nor can he say but that the writing Obligatory is his act and deed and that the debt therein Mentio
ned is yett due and unsatisfied wherefore the said p^r Crayth Judgment for his debt and his costs
and damages sustained by Evasion of the detaining the same debt to him to be adjudged &

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here the Sixteen the day of Novemb.
and Done One thousand Seven hundred and twenty five that the said Joseph M^r Maister Recover
against the said Walter T aylor as well the Sum of two thousand three hundred and Seventy Eight
pound of tobacco his debt as also the Sum of three hundred and seventy five pound
of tobacco for his costs and damages sustained by Evasion of the detaining of the same debt to the same
Joseph of his assent by the Court hereadjudged and the said debt in memory
memorandum the p^r by his attorney releaseth the penalty Reserving the principal debt &
Interest untill payment &
