 Court was Indebted unto y<sup>e</sup> said Joseph in Eighteen hundred & Ninety three pounds of tobacco  
 for Levies Sheriffs fees & Publick Dues to y<sup>e</sup> said Joseph before that time then & there due  
 Owing & unpaid as by account thereof hereunto annexed may in Court appear & being so  
 thereof Indebted y<sup>e</sup> said Mary whilst she was sole afterwards to wit y<sup>e</sup> day & year of duty  
 place as in Consideration thereof upon herselfe did assume and to y<sup>e</sup> said Joseph then and  
 there did faithfully promise that she y<sup>e</sup> said Mary y<sup>e</sup> said Eighteen hundred & Ninety three  
 pounds of tobacco when she should be afterwards thereunto requested she should well  
 & faithfully pay & content & altho' y<sup>e</sup> said Mary whilst she was sole four hundred & Sixty  
 four pounds of tobacco parcel of y<sup>e</sup> said Eighteen hundred & Ninety three pounds of tobacco  
 to y<sup>e</sup> said Joseph she hath paid & satisfied, yet as to One thousand four hundred & twenty

 doth refuse & deny Whereupon y<sup>e</sup> said Joseph saith he is worse & hath have damage to y<sup>e</sup> value  
 of two thousand Eight hundred & fifty Eight pounds of Tobacco & thereof he bringeth this
