

Novemb^r Court --- 1725

Whereupon the Said John Beaton in his proper person appears and thereupon the Said John Beaton at the prayer of the Esq^rs attorney afo^r is ad^jjudged to give Special Bail to the action afo^r. Thereupon a certain Edward Jones of Somerset County Esquire present here in Court in his proper person undertakes for the Said John Beaton that in case the Said Lewis Jenkins shall recover Judgment in the plea afo^r against the said John Beaton or that the Said John Beaton shall be therein convicted that then he the Said John Beaton shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his body to the custody of the Sher^{iff} of Somerset County in satisfaction hereof or that he the Said Edward Jones will do it for him &c

Whereupon the said John Beaton in his own proper person comes and defends the force and Injury when afo^r and says that he can not give way the Esq^rs his action afo^r so as afo^r against him brought nor can he say but that the Said Esq^r ought to recover his Damages by Question of the Jury afo^r to Eight pounds One Shilling Ster^{ling} and Costs of Suite against him which the Said Esq^r doth not give way &c

Therefore it is considered by the Justice here the ^{Sixteenth} day of March and Done One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty five afo^r that the afo^r Lewis Jenkins recover against the afo^r John Beaton his Damages afo^r in full afo^r Confessed to be the Sum of Eight pounds One Shilling Ster^{ling} & also the Sum of two hundred and Eighty Seven pounds of loss by the Court here ad^jjudged unto him for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suite in this behalf Said Out and Expended and the afo^r des^{ire} in Mercy &c
