And It is thereupon Ordered by the Court that the Said Jeffery Long give good Security for the Use of the Said Indenture in Case he doth not Comply with the Indenture, and Lett the Said Sailer and Catherine his wife goe free at the Expiration of four Years, Service mentioned in the Indenture &c &c

Thereupon the Said Jeffery Long Orent in Court acknowledged himselfe to be Indebted unto the Said John Sailer in twenty pound Sterling, and Mr Caldwell and William Blanner present in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto the Said John Sailer in the Sum of ten pound Sterling Each. to be Levied on their Body, goods or Chattells — Lands or Tenements for the Use of the Said John Sailer In Case the Said Jeffery Long do not Comply with the Indenture &c and discharge the Said John Sailer and Catherine his wife at the End of the four Years, Service mentioned in the Same Indenture, and Lett them goe free &c

Ordered by the Court that James Weatherly be Overseer of the Road in Nanticoke hundred in from Quantico Mill to Baron Creek Mill &c

Ordered by the Court that John Hoofington be Overseer of the Road from the Bridge in Nanticoke Marshes that Leads to James's Ferry, to Ricketts Road above Spring Hill Chappell and that the Road from Baron Creek Mill to Turkey Branch be Lett free — &c

Ordered by the Court that Nathaniel Waller be Overseer of the Road from Turkey Branch to Windsor Bridge over Broad Creek, and that Mr Caldwell be appointed the Gaboners between the Said Waller and Mr Hoofington &c

The Inhabitants of — Upon the Petition of Several the Inhabitants to have a free Ferry over Nanticoke River, for Somerset County at Vienna Town at Mr James's &c the Court being Read, and the Premises being fully and Maturely Considered by the Court — the Court be granted as prayed

It's thereupon Ordered by the Court that there shall be paid the person that will undertake to keep a free Ferry at the Place aforesaid for the Use of Somerset County (his finding a good and sufficient boat and give good attendance thereto, that may be suitable for the Ferry &c) after the rate of two thousand pound of tobacco year to be paid at the Paying of the family Levy &c

agreement for a ferry — Upon the Petition of sundry the Inhabitants of Somerset County for the keeping a free Ferry over Coromoke River at Snow Hill for the Use of the County &c the Court being Read, and the Premises being fully and Maturely Considered by the Court, the Court be granted as prayed

It's thereupon Ordered by the Court that the Court doth agree with Mr Mary Martin who being present in Court to keep a free Ferry over Coromoke River at Snow Hill and to find a good and sufficient boat fitting to ferry for horse and man without danger that have Occasion to pass and to pass over the Said Ferry and to give good attendance thereto; In consideration whereof the said Mary Martin is to be allowed after the rate of three thousand pound of tobacco year. and further it is agreed between the Court and the Said Mary Martin that the Overseer that bears the Road down to Snow Hill Ferry, on this Side Coromoke River, with his Gaboners shall keep the Highway that Leads to
