Whereupon all and singular the premises considered the said Timothy Garry is adjudged by the same Court to serve his said Master James Window, one full Year containing twelve months to commence at the Expiration of his Servitude already commenced, the said twelve months Service being adjudged full Satisfaction for all Runaway time, trouble Costs and Charges that hath accrued upon that same ans^r &c
