William Miles afterwards present in Court is ordered to give Recognizance with one Security
for his good behaviour and appearance at next Court &c but for want thereof the said
William Miles committed into the custody of the Sherif of Somerset County there to remain until
& the said Sherif present in Court took charge of the said William Miles accordingly &c

And afterwards in the said Court Lane the said William Miles in custody of the Sherif
of the County afo^r and thereupon the said William Miles acknowledged himself to be In-
debted unto the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary of the Province of Maryland in ten
pounds Sterling to be levied upon his body goods or Chattels Lands or tenement for the use
of his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors In case the said W^m
Miles do not make his personal appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County
Court of Somerset the third Tuesday of June next to answer unto his said Lordship con-
cerning all such matters and things as shall be objected against him or his said Lordship's
behalf and to stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon and not to depart
the same Court without License thereof in the mean time to be of the good behaviour
to all his Lordship's Justice people and more Especially to the said Sam^l Hopkins &c

Like wise a certain Lazarus Maddox of Somerset County Clerk Present here in Court in
his proper person undertakes for the said William Miles and acknowledged himself to
Owe and stand Justly Indebted unto the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors
in ten pounds Sterling to be levied upon his body goods or Chattels Lands or tenement for the use
of the said Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors In case the said William Miles do not make
his personal appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset the third
Tuesday of June next and to answer unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary concerning all
such matters and things as shall be then and there objected against him or his said Lordship's
behalf and to stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon and not to depart the same
Court without License thereof and in the mean time to be of the good behaviour to all his said
Lordship's Justice people and more Especially to the said Sam^l Hopkins &c
